

## PROPS POLICY AND PROCEDURE

- 1. Each teacher must submit a prop list before the start of the Eisteddfod.
- 2. A performer may only use necessary, age appropriate and safe props, provided members of the performance take these props into the stage area.
- 3. The use of fireworks, explosive-type effects, confetti, balloons, powder, water or other substances or props that cannot be retrieved by members of the performance is prohibited at any time during the eisteddfod.
- 4. Props may not be stored backstage.
- 5. Props may only be brough backstage the section before the prop are used in a performance.
- 6. Props must be removed from the stage and backstage area immediately after a performance.
- 7. Large props that must be placed on stage before a performance must be brought by the teacher and one other helper.
- 8. Smaller props must be placed on stage by the performers themselves where possible.
- 9. Prop placement may not take more that 1 minute.
- 10. No electrical or mechanical devices may be used.
- 11. No breakable props may be used.
- 12. Props will remain the studio/teacher's responsibility and the Garden Route Eisteddfod will not be held liable for any loss, damage or theft of props.
